## Oak Class

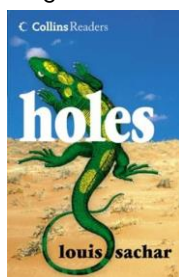
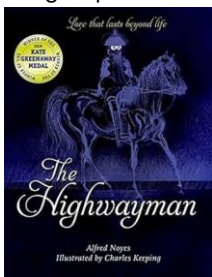
This half term, in Oak Class, we will be learning about ...

### English

This term Oak class will be reading 'The Highwayman' poem by Alfred Noyes and completing a non-chronological report on Everest. During guided reading sessions, we are reading 'Holes' by Louis Sachar and we will be looking at a range of text types from sources such as Comprehension Ninja and Literacy Shed. Our end of day story is 'Where the River Runs Gold' by Sita Brahmachari.

### Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Year 5 – Statistics, Shape, Position and Direction and Decimals and Year 6 Statistics, Shape, Position and Direction and Decimals and completing SATs. We also have a weekly arithmetic and problem-solving lesson, covering all previous learning.



### Science

In Science we are looking at 'Forces and Magnets' with lessons including: Gravity, Friction, Air Resistance and Water Resistance.

### RE

#### 'What kind of king is Jesus?'

Across the term children will answer: How do the Bible texts explain the 'Kingdom of God'? Do all Christians think of the 'Kingdom of God' in the same way? If Christians believe in a 'Kingdom of God', how is this demonstrated in their behaviour? Why is it important that Christians have the 'Kingdom of God' to aspire to? Which famous people show service in others in today's world? What can other



### History

Our history theme this term is 'The development of technology/ Does innovation mean progress?' focussing on the mining industry. We will be looking at mining through key concepts of chronology, change and continuity and evidence.

### Design & Technology

During DT lessons, children are looking at the digital world and wearable technology. They will write a program that initiates a flashing LED panel, or another pattern, on the virtual micro: bit when a button is pressed.

### PE

In PE lessons, this term, children will be taking part in badminton/ tennis and cricket lessons.

### MFL (French)

Linked to space children will learn how to describe the planets using adjectives and understand simple information about them.

### Computing

Pupils will be learning how to plan and make a story-based adventure game using the 2Create a story program.

### PSHE / RSE

Children will be undertaking the Jigsaw unit on Relationships. They will look at self-recognition and self-worth. Building self-esteem, rights and responsibilities online, dangers of online grooming, SMART internet safety rules and how to reduce screen time.
