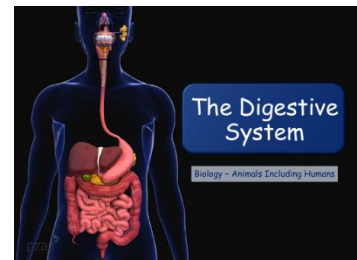




Autumn Term 1 2024

Chestnut Class

This half term, in Chestnut Class, we will be learning



English

This term Chestnut class will be working on writing a traditional tale with a twist using 'The True Story of The Three Little Pigs' by Jon Scieszka to inspire us. We will then be moving onto poetry, using the poem 'Strange' as a stimulus. Finally, we will be writing an narrative based on the story 'Star in a jar'. During guided reading sessions, we will be reading and answering questions based on the book 'A Bear Called Paddington' by Michael Bond. Our end of day story is 'The Night Bus Hero'.

Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Place Value, and Addition and Subtraction. As part of our Maths lessons, we will complete 10 minute warm ups, covering all aspects of Maths and practicing our times tables in preparation for the Year 4 times table test later in the year. Science

In Science lessons this half term we will be learning about Animals including humans. We will be learning all about the Digestive System. We will be investigating what each organ in the system does. We will then be learning about teeth and the importance of oral hygiene.

RE

Our RE big question this half term is 'What do Christians learn from the Creation Story?' Children will learn about the book of Genesis and have time for reflection We will be discussing the world around us and how God expected us to look after it.

Music

In Music lessons the children will complete a six-week unit of work based on 'Don't stop Believin'. They will listen to and appraise different tracks, sing and play instruments.



History

Our history theme this term is '20th Century Migration'. This unit looks at the big picture of migration to Britain over time. The unit as a whole builds upon previous learning and invites further reflection on the reasons for migration, the diverse experiences of different migrant groups and the impact of migration on life in Britain.

Art and Design

During Art and Design lessons, children will take inspiration from the artist Sonia Boyce. Children will learn about Sonia Boyce and her style, analyse specific artwork and explore drawing and painting techniques.

PE

In PE lessons, this term children will be learning about Tag Rugby with staff from Staindrop School and will be participating in invasion games with Sports Enterprise.

COMPUTING

In Computing, children will be completing a unit called 'Quizzing' where they will explore and create different types of quizzes.



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
