Chestnut Class

This half term, in Chestnut Class, we will be learning



English

This term Chestnut class will be working on writing a poem based on our unit 'Autumn is Here'. We will then be moving onto writing range of text types around the theme of Christmas. During guided reading sessions, we will be reading and answering questions different comprehension texts. Our end of day story is 'The Night Bus Hero.

Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Addition and Subtraction and Multiplication and Division. As part of our Maths lessons, we will complete 10 minute warm ups, covering all aspects of Maths and continuing to practice our times tables

Science

In Science we will be learning about Classification and Extinction. The children will be looking at classification keys and how to make their own. We will then study extinction and how natural phenomena is contributing to changing land and seascapes.

RE

Our RE question this term is ' What is the Trinity and why is it important to Christians?

, Children should be able explain the place of Incarnation within the 'big story' of the Bible. They will make connections between biblical texts, pieces of art work and poetry and have discussions to express their own views

Music

In Music lessons the children will complete a six-week unit of work called Classroom Jazz that builds on previous learning.



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Our geography theme this term is 'How and why have settlements changed?'. This unit looks at Know what we mean by the term settlement in geography. Children will investigate how settlements have evolved over the years and what the main human and physical reasons are for settlement changes. They will use old and new maps to check on changes to settlements.

Design Technology

During Design Technology lessons, children will be learning about seasonal foods and using their understanding to create a seasonal food tart during out unit 'Cooking and Nutrition: Eating Seasonally'.

PE

In PE lessons, this term children will be and will be participating in gymnastics with Jess and orienteering.

MFL

In MFL children will be completing the unit named 'Welcome to School', where they will learn greetings, classroom demands, numbers, days of the month and classroom objects.
