










## Chestnut Autumn Term 2025 Challenge Homework

Please find below details of Chestnut class challenges. Please note the homework covers the whole Autumn term and is to be handed in by Friday 12th December. All children in KS2 must complete at least one piece of the challenge homework. Our history theme this term is: Romans in Britain and our geography topic is Greece. In Science this term we are covering Animals including humans and Sound. Have fun completing the challenges 😊

<p><b>Geography - Greece</b></p> <p>Describe the key physical features of Greece, including its mountain ranges, major rivers and surrounding seas. How do these features influence the climate and economy of the country?</p> 	<p><b>Science - Sounds</b></p> <p>Make a tin can telephone. Can you get it to work and listen to what other people are saying. What do you have to do to make it work?</p> 	<p><b>History - Romans in Britain</b></p> <p>Write about why Boudica, the queen of the Iceni tribe, fought against the Romans and what happened during her big battle. Tell the story of her rebellion, how she destroyed Roman towns and why she is remembered as a brave leader today!</p> 
<p><b>Science - Nutrition</b></p> <p>Create a recipe book of balanced meals. What ingredients would you need? Could you create a three-course meal? What is your favourite?</p> 	<p><b>Art - Drawing and shading</b></p> <p>Create a botanical drawing using shading techniques like hatching, cross-hatching and stippling to add depth and texture. Focus on how light interacts with the plant to highlight its natural form and detail.</p> 	<p><b>Science - Skeletons</b></p> <p>Draw a simple human body outline or use a printed skeleton picture. Then label at least <b>6 important bones</b> from the list: Skull, Spine, Ribs, Pelvis, Arm bone (humerus), Leg bone (femur), kneecap (patella)</p> <p>Don't worry if you're not sure where all the bones go – give it a go!</p>
<p><b>RE/ Art - Noah</b></p> <p>Think about the art work that we have looked at in our lessons. Can you create your own piece of artwork showing the story of Noah and his ark?</p> 	<p><b>Be Creative</b></p> <p>Choose your own! 😊</p> <p>Create your own challenge homework based on any topic we have covered or will be covering in school this term.</p>	<p><b>Computing - Quizzes</b></p> <p>Create a quiz about yourself using Purple Mash. Include at least 10 questions about yourself and be sure to add multiple-choice answers and a fun title for your quiz.</p> 
<p><b>History - Historical Timeline Creation</b></p> <p>Create a poster or timeline showing key events from when the Romans came to Britain. Include important dates, people (like Julius Caesar), and what changed because of the Roman invasion.</p> 	<p><b>English -</b></p> <p>Choose a famous person and write a biography about who they are, what they're known for and interesting facts.
