Make a poster about how to take care of your teeth. Can you include how to brush your teeth properly and why?




History - Migration

Science - Classification


Create a classification key with 6 items. It could be of something in nature e.g. leaves or flowers or something different like the picture. Remember to use questions with a yes or no answer.
