# <u>Oak Class</u>

This half term, in Oak Class, we will be learning about ...





## English

This term Oak class will be working on writing a narrative using 'Zoo' by Anthony Browne to inspire us. We will then be moving onto writing speeches, using the topic of refugees as a stimulus. Finally, we will ne writing an adventure narrative. During guided reading sessions, we will be reading and answering questions based on the book 'Cool' by Michael Morpurgo. Our end of day story is 'The Night Bus Hero.

#### Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Place Value, Addition and Subtraction and Multiplication and Division. We also have a weekly arithmetic and problem-solving lesson, covering all previous learning. As part of our Maths lessons, we will complete 10 minute warm ups, covering all aspects of Maths. Scan the QR code for some great resources that you can enjoy at home.

### Science

In Science we will be learning about the life cycle of humans, then animal life cycles and reproduction, then finally plant reproduction. The children will engage in hands-on activities to aid their learning. They will learn to describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animal and will learn to describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect, bird and plant.

#### RE

Our RE question this term is 'How can following God bring freedom and justice?' By the end of the unit, children should be able to explain connections between the story of Moses and the concepts of freedom and salvation, using theological terms.

#### **Music**

In Music lessons the children will complete a six-week unit of work based on 'Don't stop Believin'. They will listen to and appraise different tracks, sing and play instruments.



## History

Our history theme this term is '20<sup>th</sup> Century Migration'. This unit looks at the big picture of migration to Britain over time. The unit as a whole builds upon previous learning and invites further reflection on the reasons for migration, the diverse experiences of different migrant groups and the impact of migration on life in Britain.

## **Art and Design**

During Art and Design lessons, children will take inspiration from the artist Sonia Boyce. Children will learn about Sonia Boyce and her style, analyse specific artwork and explore drawing and painting techniques.

#### PE

In PE lessons, this term children will be swimming and will be participating in invasion games with Sports Enterprise.

## COMPUTING

In Computing, children will be completing a unit called 'Quizzing' where they will explore and create different types of quizzes.







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
