Oak Class

This half term, in Oak Class, we will be learning about ...






English

This term Oak class will be reading 'The Nowhere Emporium' by Ross Mackenzie and completing a detailed timeline on Ancient Greece referencing 'How We Lived in Ancient Times' by Ben Hubbard. During guided reading sessions, we are looking at a range of text types from sources such as Comprehension Ninja and Literacy Shed. Our end of day story is 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty.

Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Year 5 – Decimals and Percentages, Perimeter and Area and Statistics and Year 6 Fractions, Decimals and Percentages, Perimeter and Area and Statistics. We also have a weekly arithmetic and problemsolving lesson, covering all previous learning.





Science

In Science we are looking at 'Sustainability' with lessons including:
Global Warming, Renewable Energy and

Global Warming, Renewable Energy and Solar Energy.

RE

'What difference does the resurrection make to Christians?

Across the term children will answer: Why do Christians think Jesus was resurrected? What does the bible say about the resurrection? How does the resurrection fit with other Christian Beliefs? How do Christians put their belief in the resurrection into practice? And How does belief in the resurrection bring hope to Christians?

MFI

Linked to clothing, children will learn how to describe clothes using adjectives.

Computing

Pupils will be learning what a blog / vlog is and will be planning, writing and editing their own blog. They will also understand the importance of being respectful when commenting online.

Geography

Our Geography theme is How do natural forces shape our world and how we use it?' focussing on volcanoes. We will be looking at the structure of the Earth, earthquakes, types of volcano, eruptions and natural disasters.

Art

During art lessons, we are looking at the artist William Morris. We will focus on print and design a textile/wallpaper pattern using Morris's style, techniques and influences.
