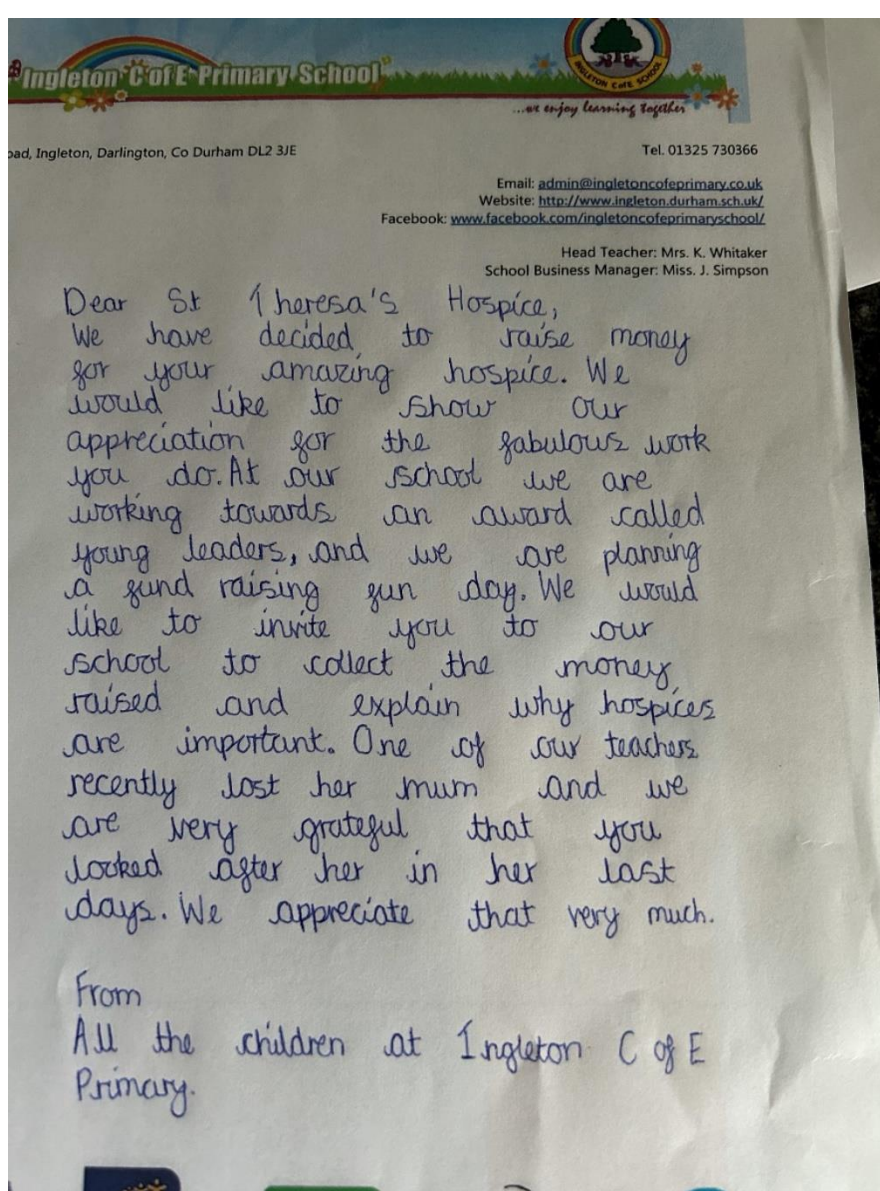


#### Fund Raising for St Teresa's Hospice Darlington - Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> July

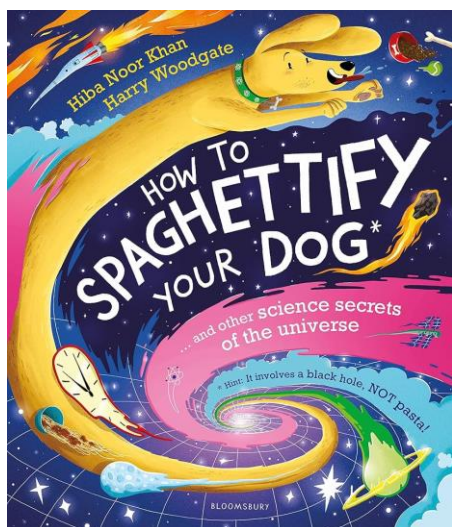

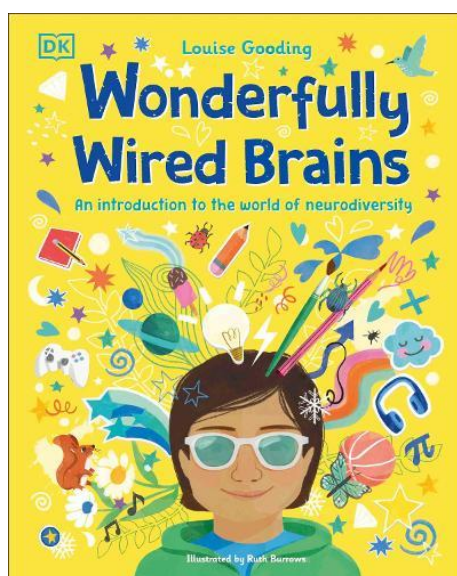

Featuring easy-to-follow experiments, eye-catching illustrations and plenty of laugh-out-loud moments, this book will demystify physics and bring science to life.

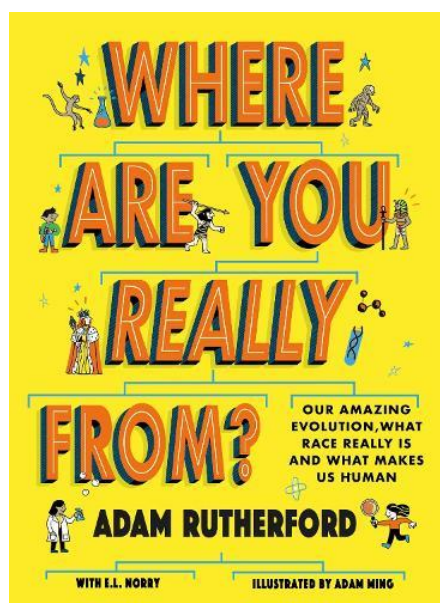
