Oak Class

This half term, in Oak Class, we will be learning about ...



English

This term Oak class will be reading 'I Believe in Unicorns' by Micheal Morpurgo. During guided reading sessions, we are finishing 'Holes' by Louis Sachar and we will be looking at a range of text types from sources such as Comprehension Ninja and Literacy Shed. Our end of day story is 'Northern Lights' by Philip Pullman.

Maths

During maths lessons, children will cover the following units: Year 5 – decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume and Year 6 – shape, position and direction, problem solving and converting units. We also have a weekly arithmetic and problem-solving lesson, covering all previous learning.



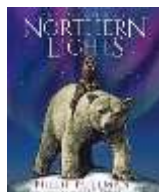
Science

In Science we are looking at 'Forces and Magnets' with lessons including: Levers and Pulleys and Rocket Science.

RE

Why is Pilgrimage important to some religious believers?

Across the term children will answer: What makes a place special? What makes a place sacred?, Is pilgrimage important for Christians?, Comparing Sikh pilgrimage to Amritsar and Muslim pilgrimage Makkah: what are the differences and similarities?, What can we find out about pilgrimage in Hinduism?, What difference does pilgrimage make in a believer's life?, Can we think of life as a pilgrimage?



Geography

Our geography theme this term is sustainable environments thinking about the question 'How do we meet human need and protect the planet?'. We will be looking at energy resources and focusing on renewable and non-renewable energy.

Art

In art lessons we are looking at the artist Joan Miró. Children will plan and create their own sculpture using Miró's style and technique of using discarded items to create forms.

PE

In PE lessons, this term, children will be taking part in athletics and practicing for Sports Day.

Music

Children will be rehearsing for the end of year production The Island That Rocks!

PSHE / RSE

Children will be undertaking the Jigsaw unit on Changing Me. They will look at self-image and body-image, puberty, future dreams and goals and growing responsibilities.



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
